

POOL RULES

1. Access to the pool must be through the front gate using a pool gate card.
2. Side gate access is for handicap use only for property owners
3. Please be courteous to pool patrons.
4. There should be no solo swimming.
5. There should be no running, boisterous, or rough play. The only toys allowed in the pool are toys specifically for a pool.
6. No swim briefs or thongs are to be worn at the pool.
7. No children under the age of 16 allowed inside pool fence without adult supervision.
8. Infants must wear swim diapers in pool.
9. Noise and sound should be maintained at minimal levels and should not disturb others.
10. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
11. There should be no spitting or blowing nose in the pool.
12. Persons with diarrhea illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
13. Persons with skin, eye, ear, or respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
14. Persons with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
15. No animals or pets allowed in the pool enclosure.
16. No glass allowed in the pool or on the deck.
17. No vaping or smoking in the pool or on the deck.
18. Food, drinks, and gum are prohibited in the pool.
19. Property owners are responsible for guest behavior.
20. This pool is open from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.
21. The pool furniture must be cared for and used in the manner for which it was intended. Please be sure that all umbrellas are tethered when leaving the pool area.
22. The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 60.
23. A first aid kit is in the DHEC box by the pump room.
24. Lifesaving equipment is located at the fence.
25. An emergency phone (or other notification device) is located on the wall of the Club House.
26. The pool operator of record at this facility is T.A. King, certification number EC 1184.

Modifications of Rules and Regulations: The Board of Directors shall reserve the right to modify or revoke existing rules and regulations and/or adopt additional rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem necessary.

Owners are responsible for compliance with the Association by their tenants and, accordingly, will be held liable for their actions.
